If there are differences, your FAFSA information may need to be corrected. You and at least one parent must complete and sign this worksheet, attach any required documents, and submit the form and other required documents to the SCCC Office of Financial Aid. The SCCC Office of Financial Aid may also ask for additional information to complete the verification process based upon this review. If you have questions about the verification process, contact our office as soon as possible so that your financial aid will not be delayed.
